

By sharing your location and details with them, it will enable local Outreach Teams to find you quickly and offer support. 0300 500 0914 https://thestreetlink.org.uk/ Please note: <u>Streetlink</u> take 2-3 days on average to get out to people and is not an emergency service.
- Westminster rough sleeping helpline- If you are sleeping rough in Westminster, call the council's 24-hour Rough Sleeping helpline on 020 7641 3841

### Places of support in Greater London

- <u>Crisis Skylight London</u> (Brent and Croydon, open 9am-5pm on weekdays.) They offer support with housing, health and employment etc.
- <u>Webber Street Day Centre</u> (Southwark, open from 8:30am Monday to Saturday). They offer cooked breakfast, access to showers, clean clothes and referrals.
- <u>Whitechapel Mission</u> (Whitechapel, open 365 days a year from 6am-3pm on weekdays and 6am-12pm on weekends when we are closed.) They offer showers, clothes, breakfast and advice.
